

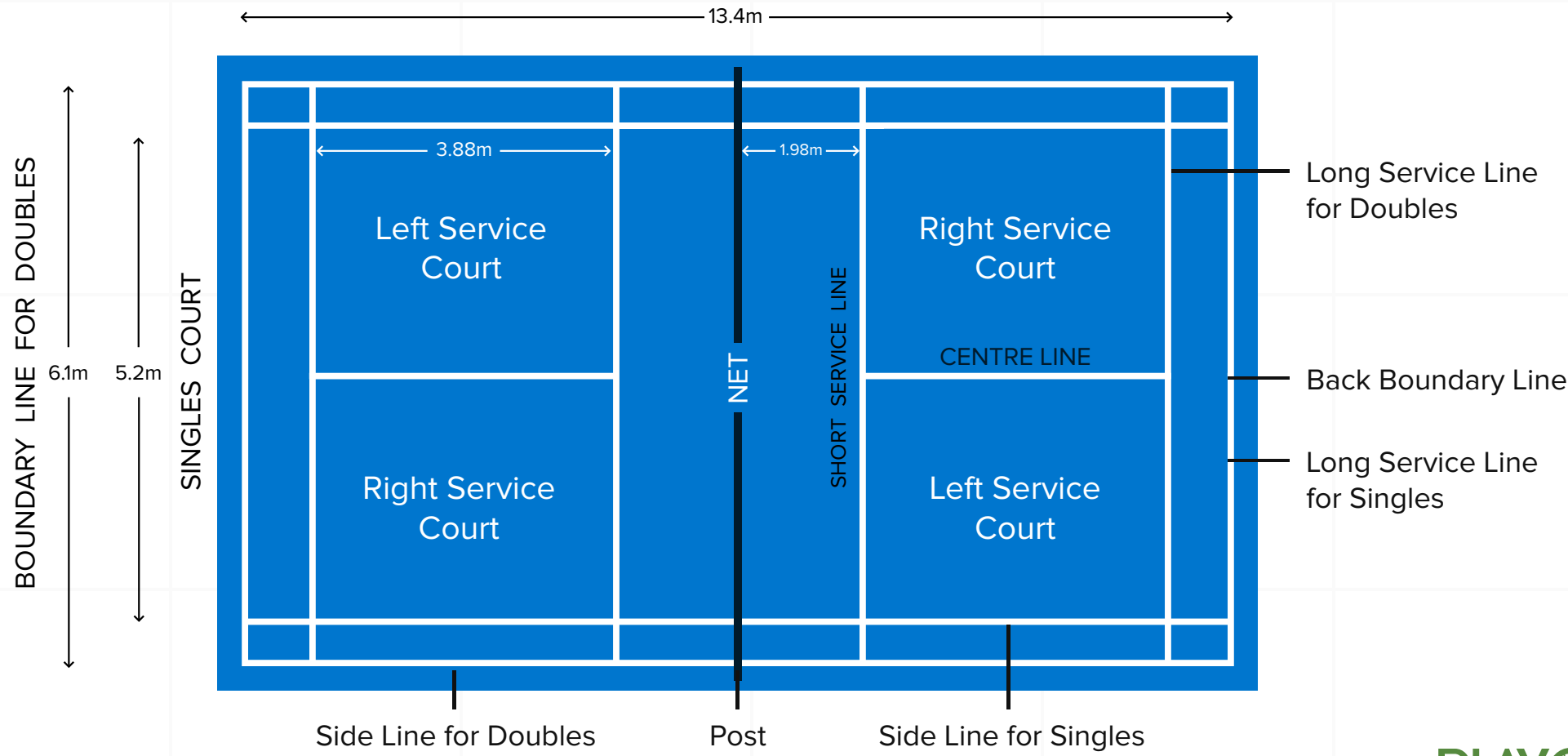
All About BADMINTON

Types of Badminton Surfaces

Most of the courts generally install Synthetic, Wooden or Acrylic type of flooring



SYNTHETIC

- Good bounce and anti-slippery
- Rs.300 / square feet (approx.)
- 5 years warranty



WOODEN

- High resistance to wear and tear
- Rs.320 / square feet (approx.)
- 8 years warranty



ACRYLIC

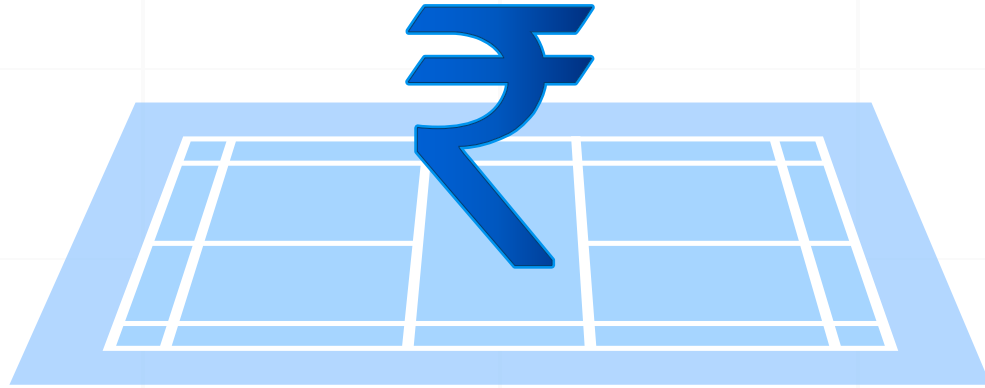
- Exceptional strength and durability
- Rs.400 / square feet (approx.)
- 8 years warranty

Cost of Constructing Courts

Cost of the flooring and land may differ from place to place
1 to 1.5 Lakh for cementing the floor.

SYNTHETIC FLOORING

- 1 Lakh - 15Lakh
- Durable and anti-slip
- PVC/ PU material
- 5 years warranty

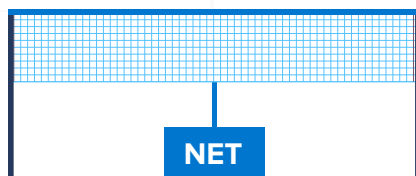


WOODEN FLOORING

- 4-5 Lakh
- Cost effective
- Teak / Sagwan wood
- 5 years warranty

Isometric
Oval

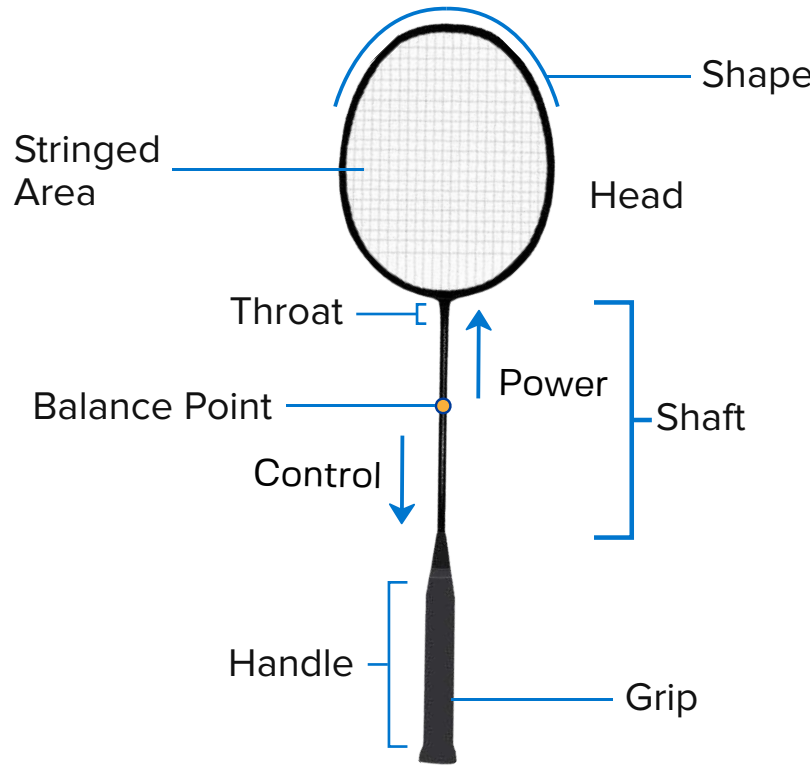
ISOMETRIC

- Enlarge sweet spot
- Better power on shots
- Attacking game style

OVAL

- Concentrated sweet spot
- Less power on shots
- Better Aerodynamics

Racket



GRIP

- 102mm G2
- 95mm G3
- 89mm G4
- 83mm G5

TOWEL

- Softer and Absorbs sweat
- Requires frequent replacement
- Weighs down the racket

SYNTHETIC

- Enhances power
- Can be slippery at times
- Poor sweat absorption ability

Easier to handle and minimizes the strength

HEAD LIGHT RACKETS

Easy to swing than Head Heavy Rackets

Weights of Rackets

A majority of racket manufacturers use 1U, 2U, 3U, 4U, 5U to indicate the weight of the racket, 1U being the heaviest and 5U the lightest.

FEATHER

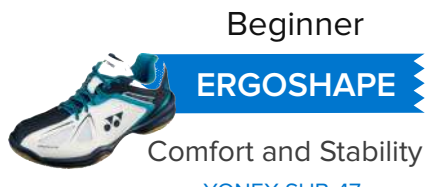
- Types of Feather - GOOSE & DUCK
- Used in Pro-level/Competitions
- Light in weight, requires power
- Damages easily



SYNTHETIC

- Types of Synthetic - NYLON & PLASTIC
- Used in Schools, small clubs for training
- Requires less power
- Cheaper than feather, last longer

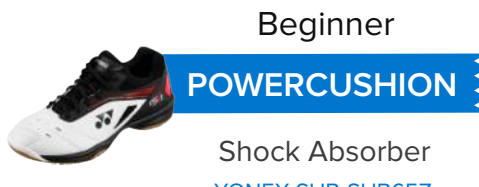

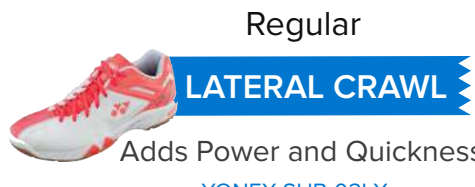

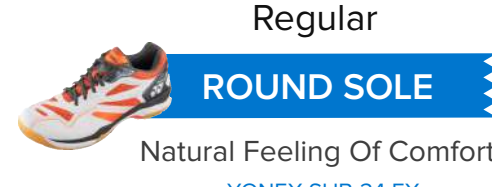
